Miniatures in Minutes Supply List:

- Terrie Sandelin's book Miniatures in Minutes
- Fabric listed on page 41
- Neutral cotton thread
- Permanent extra-fine markers in 3 colors
- Clover Mini Iron and portable ironing surface
- Elmer's white washable school glue, 4oz. bottle
- Elmer's washable glue stick
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter
- Ruler and mat
- Transparent tape
- Any other sewing supplies you need

- I will have the foundation paper printed for you.

- Have your glue bottle prepared with a fine tip.

- Please have your fabric cut in 1 inch squares and marked. You will need the following numbers of squares for each row(letter):
A – 4 B – 8 C – 12 D – 16 E – 20 F – 24
G – 24 H – 20 I – 16 J – 12 K – 8 L – 4 M – 1

- Please note you can repeat fabrics as long as they are not rows next to each other.
